Recap: Business Applications: ERP


• ERP - enterprise resource planning

HOW TO USE CLOUD SERVICES

How to Use Cloud Services

• SaaS

- Most common used on most apps on mobile devices & PCs
- Open Browser/open app > Access website (if applicable) > Login > Use
- Demo: Atlassian Jira

• IaaS

- Provider hosts, maintains, and updates backend infrastructure compute, storage, networking, virtualization
- Open Browser > Login > access panel (ie. Cpanel) > configure and monitor settings > use
- Demo: Hostinger

• PaaS

- Commonly accessible through a website portal/landing page
- Access Website> login > select application> develop & test > deploy/use
- Demo: Microsoft Azure




